ECNHWA Meeting 8th September 2021

Tendring Neighbourhood Watch are due to hold their AGM on 9th September at SAMS Hall Imperial House. Rosemary Road, Clacton on Sea starting at 7.30pm.

The Acting Chairman and the Secretary met with the Community Policing Team, the head of Citizens in Policing and our Essex Watch Liaison Officer on the 3rd of September at Clacton Police Station, the main points of the meeting were to try and get a more visible profile for Tendring Neighbourhood Watch across the Tendring District. There were a lot of ideas discussed and the Tendring NHW representatives said they would start to implement them after the AGM. Without a permanent Chairperson for Tendring NHW it is extremely difficult to get a lot of actions carried out. There were hopes that a permanent Chairperson and District Coordinator will be found at the AGM.

Tendring Neighbourhood Watch are hoping to be taking part in a Street Action Day arranged by Tendring District Council's Community Safety Partnership this was planned to take place in the Brooklands and Grasslands area of Jaywick Sands on the 15th of September. We have asked Jaywick Sands NHW to engage with this Street Action Day.

The Community Policing Team are now in touch with Tendring Neighbourhood Watch's Street Coordinators in Brightlingsea. There is now a constant flow of information from the Community Policing Team in Brightlingsea to the Coordinators and to the Acting District Coordinator for Tendring NHW.
