Essential Guide for attending the event

The Village Hall and Play Area is used by children and this community event has been granted permission to go ahead by North Huish Parish Council subject to a few restrictions. In addition there are some additional requests that we hope you will actively support in order to make your afternoon a safe and fun one:

- **Glass** Please DO NOT bring any glass items into the event/play area site; with the exception of competition entries.
- **Smoking and Dogs** No smoking or dogs within the event site boundaries; with the exception of registered guide dogs
- **Play Park** There will be a restriction of use on the weekend of the event by the general public who are not attending the event. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. However health & safety is a priority with vehicles having access at certain times. The Play Park will be accessible to all people attending the event.
- Alcohol No alcohol to be brought to the event or taken away
- **Minimum Age** If you are over 18 years old and would like to purchase alcoholic refreshments but think you may be asked your age, to save embarrassment, please make sure you bring suitable Photographic ID
- **Car Park** Please DO NOT park at the Avon Inn to attend the event unless you have prior permission; there is a designated event car park nearby and a drop off point near the entrance gate. There is no parking on the event site.
- **Disabled Access-** Please note that the area is a short grass field and may be uneven.
- Toilets A disabled toilet is provided on site with hand-washing facilities for all to use
- Services There is no water or electricity available on site

Competition Rules for Exhibitors

General - All entries must be home made. No shop bought fillings, pastry or preserves. Each entry will need with it a small postcard size card with your name, contact details, the name of the recipe and ingredients including the apple variety where used. Only 1 entry per class per person. Apple pies will be automatically entered into category B. The event organisers cannot be responsible for the loss or damage of entries, containers or plates. All exhibits must be delivered to the Marquee next to the play park between 10.00am and 11.00am and collected between 4.30pm and 5.30pm. All exhibitors will need to pay the event entrance fee. The decision of the Judges is final.

Apple Pies - Apples must be the main ingredient, although other fruits and ingredients can be used. Please put your full name on the bottom of the pie container and enclose your entry in a clear bag for hygiene. Double crust means a layer of pastry lining the tin, a filling and a pastry lid. Judges will be looking at Appearance; Pastry; Taste; Texture; Creativity.

Longest Apple Peel – The apple peel must be intact when given to the competition organiser in the marquee. Please bring your entry carefully in a box or bag. The apple peel may be cut by the organiser so that it can be measured accurately using a metre ruler. Any variety of apple can be used. Please write your name, age and contact details on a card with your entry

Art Collage Theme for this year is Children (under 13 years old) : The Hungry Caterpillar Adults (Over 13 years old): The Orchard. A4 size, un-mounted, using natural materials with the addition of paint, pencil, charcoal or pastel. Over 50% of the materials must be collage.

Jar of Preserve (Sweet) – Any home-made sweet jam, jelly or curd. Jars must be sealed and labelled with its recipe name. Please include a postcard size card with your name, contact details, the name of the recipe and ingredients written on **one side only**.

Jar of Preserve (Savoury) – Any home-made chutney, pickle or relish. Jars must be sealed and labelled with its recipe name. Please include a postcard size card with your name, contact details, the name of the recipe and ingredients written on **one side only**.

Competition Guidelines

Any entries not abiding by the competition rules will be disqualified. All prize money and certificates will be presented to winners at 4pm on the day.





Apple Pressing Guide 12 noon to 4pm



Freshly pressed apple juice tastes wonderful! Any varieties of eating apples can be used. You can drink the juice on the day, freeze it or pasteurise it in glass bottles at home for use later. Of course you can always have a go at making some homemade cider!

If you would like to bring your apples to be pressed for apple juice please remove any mouldy apples, wash any debris or mud off with tap water and slice apples into quarters just before you bring them. You will need sterilised containers to take your juice home: empty plastic milk containers are ideal. Max weight per pressing – 11kg apples (approx. 1 to 2 full carrier bags) should yield 5.5 litres juice. Please bring your own rubber gloves for hygiene. Dirty or mouldy apples will not be milled and pressed. Bruised or dented apples are fine. One pressing per person or family. Please label your bags of prepared apples with your name.

The first part will be crushing your apples into small pieces. Then put in the small apple press and turn the handle and watch your fresh juice pour out of the base of the press into a container. At this point you could add your own ascorbic acid (Vitamin C) to reduce dis-colouration; the choice is yours. The juice is then funnelled into your sterilised containers. The press is then cleaned of apple bits known as 'pomice', rinsed and ready for the next pressing. You can take the pressed 'pomice' home if you like to make home-made pectin or a weak form of cider called 'ciderkin'. The pomice may be too acidic for your compost heap.

Please make sure you help prepare all the equipment for the next pressing.
