

It's been too long.....from **July 4th** we will be returning to normality and starting to welcome you back to the Larder!!!

In many ways this will be a new era for us all, and we will need to work together to make it as safe as possible for our staff and customers alike so in that respect, we have taken government guidance into account and put in place the following steps;

Seating capacity – This will be greatly reduced so that we can adhere to the distancing guidance, and to allow clear space for our staff and take-away customers to move freely and safely within the constraints. Weather permitting, we will once again also be able to offer tables of 2 outside subject to availability.

Availability – with capacity in mind, we would advise you to book in advance by phone or through Facebook and messenger and we will either confirm or offer alternatives if we cannot accommodate you. We will only be able to take walk-in diners if we are confident it has no impact on the safety of others, so we do not want to offend anyone by having to turn them away.

Table sizes – We will be commencing with groups of no bigger than 4, until further notice. We would ask that these groups be from single families, known groups or support bubbles.

Customer information – we will be asking for some basic information from customers, that can be easily completed whilst we prepare your orders. Names, time and date of visit, and contact details will be logged and securely stored away from the premises and retained until further notice.

Payment – As the till area needs to be kept clear, card payments will be taken remotely and contactless at the table, or cash payments redeemed by us and change returned to the table.

To add to these precautions, we are confident that the Larder team will still be able to make your visit as pleasant as usual, whilst staying safe. We will be operating a small team in all areas so that we keep our distance from each other, and customers as best possible.

The whole premises has been deep cleaned during closure, and all equipment, surfaces and touch points will continue to be frequently sanitized, and contact in all areas minimised for your safety.

We would also request that anyone showing symptoms of illness DOES NOT try to either book or enter the premises, for the safety of other customers and our staff. We retain the right to be able to either respectfully refuse entry to or remove anyone that we view as showing symptoms of sickness.
