

Getting married at St Mary's – 2017 costs

The fee set by law	£424
Your marriage certificate	£4
Having your banns read*	£28*
Organist's fee	£220
Verger's fee	£25
Clerk's fee	£10
Utilities and maintenance	£45

* Banns must be read at St Mary's and in the parish church(es) where you live if this is different. This costs £40 for each parish (£27 for the banns and £13 for a certificate which must be given to the priest marrying you before the wedding). If you live in St Mary's parish then the banns need only be read here with the cost as in the list above. Some couples will need to obtain a Common Licence instead of banns and this costs around £200 (speak with us about this).

** Not included if you are getting married in The Old Church.

A non-refundable deposit of £150 is required to confirm your booking. The full fee is payable a month before the service. It is important to note that the organist and the verger are paid for their time, so if your wedding finishes later than arranged we may require additional payment to cover this.
