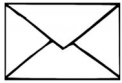

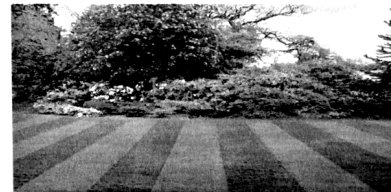

Easy Fish Pie

1 smoked cod fillet, (undyed) from wet fish counter Waitrose, or Tesco. Place fillet in a large pan and add some milk 1/2 pt. plus a knob of butter cook slowly on hob until milk boils. Spoon over the fish and then turn off and leave for 5mins.



Take fish out of pan and put on plate to cool. Meanwhile using warm milk make a white sauce. Flake the cooked fish into the white sauce and then pour into a bowl. When cool cover your fish mixture with some mashed potato and grate some parmesan cheese on top of the potato. Bake in the oven for 40mins at 175deg. Serve with peas, spinach or what ever you fancy. Enjoy.

As Christmas is coming many people will be having Turkey, Chicken, or Goose on the big day - if you are remember the carcass boiled in water with a bay leaf, a diced onion makes delicious stock which can be frozen and is the backbone to making wonderful soup
