## BRAMSHALL AND DISTRICT GARDENING CLUB

It was lovely to see colourful flowers filling a large area of the Village Hall for the January meeting when Byron Lewis of Lichfield Garden Centre came to present his Spring Plant Showcase. The plants he brought included Hellebores, Primulas, Polyanthus, Cyclamen and various evergreens and grasses. Of particular interest was *Erisimum Arista* which has been developed from the wallflower and will apparently flower for most of the year for up to 5 years, eventually becoming a colourful bush about 2ft high.

He also brought some interesting hanging baskets designed by Laura Ashley – certainly out of the ordinary-- and newly-introduced large patio pots which are plastic but glazed to look like pottery ones. He was very positive about a new sort of slug pellet which is derived from sheep's wool – apparently this is too dry and abrasive for slugs to climb over. It was a very useful evening – both for his useful tips and for the plants, many of which were sold.

The next meeting will take place at Bramshall Parish Hall on **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March at 7:30pm**. Gerald Ingram, joint owner of Planters Garden Centre in Tamworth, will give an illustrated talk on how to design and plant a successful patio garden.

## Recipe

### Sweet Red Pepper and Tomato Soup.

1tbsp Olive oil. 2 tbsp water, 2 red peppers, chopped and deseeded.  
1 clove of garlic, chopped,. 1 onion., chopped, 14oz tin of chopped tomatoes.  
2 pints of vegetable stock. Salt & pepper.

Put the oil. water, peppers, onions and garlic in a saucepan and heat gently. Cook for about 10 minutes until softened. Cover the pan and simmer for another 10 minutes, then add tomatoes, stock, salt and pepper and simmer for 15 minutes. Allow to cool and then liquidise. Enjoy with some fresh, crusty bread.

This soup is very similar to a gazpacho which is a delicious cold summer soup. I did the recipe for that some time ago - I love it as a cold soup . However, the summer is some way off so I hope you enjoy this warmer version which is very good.
