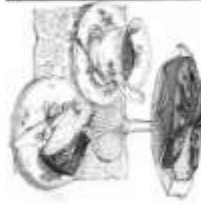
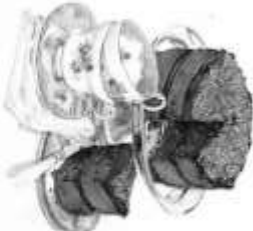

The FB Pocket Orchestra takes its listeners back to the hot jazz, blues, ragtime & popular dances of the 1920/30s & earlier. They are without a doubt one of the best jazz bands working the circuit today and having been applying their trade since they formed back in 2012 they have had years to turn themselves into the well-oiled music machine that they now are. So it's time to come along and get yourselves ready for a 1920s style night on the town.





BRAMSHALL AND DISTRICT GARDENING CLUB

The first meeting of the new season was a real revelation. Diane Clement presented some magnificent slides (all fully labelled with Latin plant names!) and she spoke about how to achieve a colourful garden during every month of the year. Her garden is not large and is north facing on a busy road in Wolverhampton but she has produced a garden which has colour and interest from January to December. She has carefully arranged the plants so that, as one set die off, another set spring up and replace them, thus maximising garden space and reducing the amount of work required.

The most difficult time of year to prevent the garden looking dead is winter but she had found that the plants to use to brighten the garden for this season are *Cyclamen Coum*, *Hellebore*, Winter aconite, Witch-Hazel and various species of Snowdrop. Many of her plants were unusual, such as the *Trillium*, *Erythronium* (Dog's Tooth Violet), *Arbutus* (Strawberry Tree), various Orchids (obtained from specialist nurseries) and *Meconopsis* (Blue Himalayan Poppy). One would not have thought that they could be grown in a garden in the Midlands but her photographs showed that they were well established and flourishing. The evening was an inspiration to us all!

The November meeting of the new season will be at Bramshall Parish Hall on Monday 26th November at 7:30pm when local Environmental Scientist Michael Swales will give a well-informed and useful talk on Invasive Species and possible ways of dealing with them.

RECIPE

Spaghetti carbonara

1/2 lb (225g) spaghetti, 1 1/2 tbsp olive oil, 4oz streaky bacon chopped into small pieces

2 large eggs,

1 1/2 tbsp grated Parmesan cheese, salt & freshly milled black pepper, extra Parmesan cheese for serving.

Place the pasta in a large pan of boiling water and add half a tablespoon of oil to the water. Cook the pasta to your liking. Add the remaining oil to a saucepan and fry the chopped bacon until cooked.

Whisk the eggs in a bowl and add pepper and 1tbsp of parmesan cheese.

Drain the pasta and return to a hot pan (not on heat). Stir in the beaten eggs, bacon and the oil the bacon was cooked in. Stir so that the pasta is coated with the egg and bacon mixture.

Heat slowly until the egg mixture turns slightly granular and serve onto hot plates with lots of grated parmesan cheese.

I must add that I do add to the bacon mixture some freshly crushed garlic and also a couple of spoons of fresh cream to the egg mixture.

I hope you enjoy.
