# "Speedwatch"

The "Speedwatch" team of volunteers, just myself and SallyAnne Lander at present, carried out two speed monitoring exercises prior to Christmas. Each shift lasts 2 hours - of which approximately 20 minutes is taken to set up which leaves 1 hour 40 minutes of recording time.

Our first shift was on Stocks Lane/Leigh Lane at the end of September when 5 vehicles were recorded exceeding the speed limit of 30mph.

Then in early December we carried out monitoring of Stone Road, near the Old Bramshall Inn, and during the period we were there, recorded 25 vehicles exceeding the speed limit of 30mph, including a motorcyclist with "L" plates who passed us at 38mph! The highest offending vehicle (a white transit van) passed us at 56mph, making no attempt to slow down.

Details of the offending vehicles have been passed to the Staffordshire Safer Roads Partnership to follow up each case with a view to possible prosecution.

There are still opportunities for volunteers to join the Bramshall Community Speedwatch Team and training is available to all volunteers.

#### Electoral Roll

Notice is hereby given that the St Lawrence Church Electoral Roll is to be open for review between 1<sup>st</sup> February and 28th February 2017. Under the Church Representation Rules persons are entitled to have their names entered on the roll if they:

Are baptized and will be 16yrs of age during the year of 2017 (those aged under 16 may not vote before their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday).

Have signed a form of application for enrolment, and either

Are members of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England being resident in the parish, or (not being resident in the parish) having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to the application for enrolment; or

Are members in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity declaring themselves to be also members of the Church of England and having habitually attended public worship during the six month period prior to enrolment.

Forms of application for enrolment can be obtained from the undersigned. In order to be entitled to attend the annual parochial church meeting, and to take part in its proceedings, forms of application for enrolment must be returned by the 28<sup>th</sup> February 2017, if you are not already on the electoral roll. The new Electoral Roll will be available for inspection in church from Sunday 12th March. Any error discovered in the roll should be reported at once to the PCC Secretary/Electoral Roll Officer. 

We have recently returned from visiting our son, Christopher (late of Bramshall), and his Chinese wife, Ariel, living in Beijing, China. Not having seen Christopher for almost five years made this visit particularly poignant.

We have travelled to China on four occasions previously visiting not just Beijing but also Shanghai, X'ian and Hong Kong. It was during a visit to Beijing in 2008 which Christopher joined in that we first met Ariel who was our tour guide whilst we were in the city. From that first encounter who could ever have imagined that a new family relationship would blossom?

Christopher moved from Bramshall to Beijing in 2010 to take up a role with the RISE educational organisation, teaching young Chinese schoolchildren to speak English. His relationship with Ariel developed and they married in China in 2013. After more than five years he still enjoys his daily toils as he calls them and is becoming quite proficient at speaking Chinese. He does however confess that learning to write in Mandarin is taking considerably longer and many evenings are spent with language and writing lessons.

#### Brussels Sprout Soup.

For 6 people
2lb sprouts, 8oz potatoes, 1 onion,
2oz butter, ½ pint milk, black pepper,
½ teaspoon grated nutmeg,
¼ pint single cream,
about 2 pints of chicken stock.

Trim and wash the sprouts and thinly slice the potato and onion. Melt the butter in a large saucepan and cook the onions and potato slowly for about 10 minutes until the onion is slightly soft. Toss in the sprouts and pour in the stock. Bring the mixture to the boil and simmer for 20 minutes. Add salt and pepper to taste.

Allow the soup to cool for a few minutes before pouring into the liquidiser- or you can rub through a sieve. Stir in the nutmeg and cream. You can then refrigerate or re-heat carefully making sure the mixture does not boil as the cream will clot and go lumpy.

Sprouts are associated with Christmas dinner but this soup is lovely at any time.
