

BRAMSHALL PARISH HALL COMMITTEE MEETING

Minutes of the previous meeting dated 7th November 2016 were read, confirmed and signed as a true and correct record.

Matters Arising:

Due to the street lighting not working in the car park highlighted by a recent fall in the car park, the bulkhead lights have been put on a timer. The streetlights are to be updated to LED and the electrician is awaiting new fittings.

The Hand driers in the toilets have been installed. A hand towel dispenser and soap dispenser are installed in the kitchen.

New windows have been installed down the side of the hall (3-off).

Autumn Fayre. This was very successful, with the money raised

John Whittaker plaque in the hall – It was decided not to go ahead with this as there is already other recognition in the village.

Planning permission at the church – They now have Faculty. It will be approximately 3 months work, but this is not yet funded.

Kitchen update – New quotes available from B&Q & Howdens. Decision made for Howdens: No wall units, double sink, Quote required for floor from D. Waldron. Quote for fitting from AS Joinery.

Currently no one is emptying the bins in the Hall. A contract is required with Cathedral for emptying sanitary bins.

Bramshall Meadows. A leaflet drop highlighting Church and village activities has been done & another is planned for Easter time

Treasurer's report: £1792 in the current account. The windows cost £595, Electrics £693, £470 income from investments.

Booking Secretary's Report: Bookings are reasonable for the forthcoming period. The Durose Weekend is 15/16 July. 4th May the Hall is to be used as a polling station. Geoff has advised that he is happy to continue in this position but will not be able to attend Parish Hall meetings

Maintenance: The sound monitor is broken, Issues in the disabled toilet. A quote is required for the trees to be professionally cut. ESBC have said that all trees within the boundary are the responsibility of the Parish Hall, while previously it was only the Silver Birch.
Easter date for clearing the footpath: 19th April

BKV – We come in the small village category with population up to 1500, with 280 homes in the Parish (not all in the village). The map requires updating. The first round of inspection is 1/5-18/6, Area final:26/6-9/7, County final 17/7-22/7. Presentation evening 7/8. We propose to get a date in March to ask children to do posters.
