Mark 10: 46-52	Bartimaeus (“What do you want Me to do for you?”)
Luke 1: 26-38	Annunciation
Luke 5: 12-16	Healing of the leper (“I do choose. Be made clean.”)
Luke 11: 1-13	Teach us to pray (Lord’s prayer + perseverance + ask...)
Luke 12: 22-32	Trust in Providence (“Therefore do not worry ...”)
John 1: 35-42	What do you want? (First disciples follow)

TRUST

Matthew 6: 24-34	Do not worry (“Seek first ...”)
Matthew 14: 22-33	Walking on the water (Jesus and Peter)
Mark 4: 35-41	Calming of the storm
Luke 1: 26-38	Annunciation
Luke 12: 22-32	Trust in Providence (“Therefore do not worry ...”)
Luke 21: 1-4	The widow’s mite
John 15: 1-8	Apart from Me you can do nothing (The true vine)
Romans 8: 31-39	If God is for us, who is against us? (Nothing can separate...)
Philippians 4: 8-13	I can do all things (+ whatever is true ...)

MARY

Luke 1: 26-38	Annunciation
Luke 1: 39-45	Visitation (“Blessed is she who believed ...”)
Luke 2: 1-20	Nativity
Luke 2: 22-38	Presentation (+ Simeon and Anna)
Luke 2: 39-40, 51-52	Hidden life
Luke 2: 41-50	Finding in the Temple
John 2: 1-12	Wedding at Cana
John 19: 25-28	Mary at the foot of the Cross
Acts 1: 12-14	After the resurrection (with disciples in upper room)

HEALING AND RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS

Mark 1: 40-45	Healing of the leper (“I do choose. Be made clean.”)
Mark 5: 21-24,35-43	Jairus’s daughter
Mark 5: 25-34	Woman with the haemorrhage
Mark 7: 31-37	Healing of a deaf man (also with speech impediment)
Mark 8: 22-26	Healing of a blind man (second touch)
Mark 10: 46-52	Bartimaeus (“What do you want Me to do for you?”)
Luke 5: 12-16	Healing of the leper (“I do choose. Be made clean.”)
Luke 7: 39-50	A sinful woman forgiven (chez Simon the Pharisee)
Luke 13: 10-17	The crippled woman (18 years bent over)
John 4: 1-24	The Samaritan woman at the well
John 5: 1-9 (or 18)	The man at the pool (“Do you want to be made well?”)
John 8: 1-11	Woman caught in adultery (“anyone who is without sin”)

GOD DESIRES TO FORGIVE US

Matthew 9: 10-13	“I came to call sinners”
Luke 7: 39-50	A sinful woman forgiven (chez Simon the Pharisee)
Luke 15: 11-32	Prodigal son
Luke 18: 9-14	Pharisee and publican
Luke 19: 1-10	Zachaeus
Luke 23: 33-34	“Father, forgive them...”
Luke 23: 39-43	Good thief
John 4: 5-42	Woman at the well (+ “My food is to do the will...”)
John 8: 1-11	Woman caught in adultery (“anyone who is without sin”)
John 21: 15-19	Jesus forgives and restores Peter

OUR FORGIVING OTHERS

Matthew 5: 20-26	Leave your gift
Matthew 5: 43-48	Love your enemies
Matthew 6: 7-16	How to pray (inc. Lord’s Prayer + fasting)
Matthew 7: 1-5	Do not judge
Luke 23: 33-34	“Father, forgive them...”
John 13: 1-17	Washing the disciples’ feet
1 Corinthians 13: 4-13	“Love is patient; love is kind...”

COMPASSION

Luke 10: 25-37	The Good Samaritan (“What must I do to inherit...?”)
Luke 15: 11-24	Lost son and loving father
Luke 16: 19-31	Rich man and Lazarus
Luke 23: 32-43	“Father, forgive them” (+ promise to thief)

JESUS AND PRAYER

Matthew 14: 22-25	Jesus prays alone (post 5000 and pre walking on water)
Mark 1: 35-39	Jesus prays alone (early morning in Capernaum)
Luke 3: 21-22	Jesus is baptised
Luke 5: 15-16	Jesus prays alone (His custom)
Luke 6: 12-16	Jesus prays before choosing the 12 disciples
Luke 9: 18-21	While Jesus prays – “Who do you say that I am?”
Luke 9: 28-36	The transfiguration (“while He was praying”)
Luke 11: 1-13	Teach us to pray (Lord’s prayer + perseverance + ask...)
Luke 22: 39-46	Jesus prays in His agony

CLOSING

Luke 24: 13-35	Road to Emmaus
John 13: 1-15	Washing the disciples’ feet
John 21: 15-17	“Do you love Me?”
Romans 8: 31-39	“If God is for us...” (hymn to God’s love)
Philippians 1: 3-11	“He who began a good work in you...”
Philippians 4: 4-9	“Rejoice in the Lord always (+ “keep on doing ...”)
