Child Protection - Student Adjustment

A certain times it may be necessary to physically adjust the movements of a student during class. All genres of dance and theatre are physical in nature and require accuracy of limb placement. This is to ensure correct posture, positioning and to prevent injury.

Behavior

Dynam-nic Theatre prides itself on being a happy learning environment with enjoyment being at the root of all our classes. This policy exists to maintain this environment and enable pupils to reach their full potential.

Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated; teachers reserve the right to deal with the behavior how they see fit, through encouragement and guidance. Time is given for students to settle in a new class however if physical disruption occurs, parents will be informed if the teacher feels that their behavior is disturbing the enjoyment and development of other pupils. If a teacher feels that the behavior of an individual is continuously disruptive, the pupil may be asked to leave.

Behavior in unsupervised areas, eg changing rooms and toilets, must be acceptable and in line with our behavior policy. Parents/guardians are responsible for students out of class times.

Lost Property

The school will not take any responsibility for lost property. Any belongings found will be kept in the lost property bag for one term before been donated to a local charity shop.

Uniform

Uniform provides a disciplined approach to class, it allows teachers to see body alignment and allows students to feel part of a team and ready to perform!

Payment

Fees are payable by the term and no refunds will be given for a student who decides to stop a class mid term
Any fees not paid by the stated due date will incur a £4 late fee

Absence

Refunds will not be given to those who cannot attend class due to holidays, trips, parties and short illness.
