Terms and Conditions

Deans Court Vintage Brocante Bank Holiday Monday 27th August 2018

The Larmer Tree Vintage Brocante Friday 30th November & Saturday 1st December 2018

Please read carefully

1. The Exhibitor shall assume full responsibility, therefore including liability for all claims arising out of the fair, handling or housing of such exhibits and the conduct of the stand generally. The Exhibitor shall indemnify the organisers against all claims, damages or expenses whatsoever, in any way, arising out of the presence of the exhibitor or his exhibits on site.
2. The Organisers/Owners will not be responsible for the death, injury, disease or loss caused to any exhibitor or customer.
3. All temporary structures, information boards, exhibits and free standing stock, are to be safe for their intended purpose.
4. The Event Organiser/Owner will not be responsible for the safe erection of the temporary structure (e.g. gazebo) whilst on site. The persons responsible for erecting the structure are liable for any damages caused to the building, contents, visitors and Exhibitors. This rule will also apply to any contractor or sub-contractor employed on site.
5. Accidents
The Organisers will not be responsible for any accidents, fatal or otherwise, that may arise from an exhibitor holding a stand or exhibition area at the event. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Organisers blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident/s.
6. Exhibitors agree by signing this document they have the appropriate insurance regarding their own property, but also third party claims e.g. public liability insurance.
7. The Organisers/Owners will not be responsible for the safe keeping of any article exhibited and will require exhibitors to take charge of their own property. Security will be provided overnight.
8. Reservations cannot be accepted by phone or email; bookings will only be accepted on the official booking form, with payment by online BACS accompanied by appropriate insurance cover.

9. Cancellations by Stallholders

If you decide to cancel your stall booking over 28 days prior to the event (Deans Court 30th July 2018 and the Larmer Tree 2nd November 2018), we will refund 50% of your stall fee. Cancellations made within 28 days of the event will result in the loss of the stall fee.

10. The Dorset Brocante will endeavour to ensure the Fair goes ahead as advertised. However, we cannot be held responsible for events, which are outside our control, such as adverse weather conditions, or events, which lead to a change in, or cancellation of the fair. In the unlikely event of the fair being cancelled, or the venue being unavailable owing to circumstances beyond our control, we are unable to refund booking fees.

11. Exhibitors agree by signing this document they have the appropriate insurance regarding their own property, but also against third party claims e.g. public liability insurance.

12. Your Data Protection is important to us and we shall never disclose your personal information to third parties. The information you provide shall be used solely in connection with contacting you and running the Brocante, and shall be destroyed after each event. You will therefore need to submit new details each time you apply for a stall. This is to protect your privacy.
