## **The Sacred Triduum**

### **MAUNDY THURSDAY**

The Mass of the Lord's Supper will take place at 7pm at Holy Rood. At the conclusion of the Mass the Blessed Sacrament will be processed through the Church to the Altar of Repose. Please remember to kneel as the Blessed Sacrament passes by. Once the Blessed Sacrament has been reposed the traditional stripping of the Altar and Sanctuary with the accompanying psalms will be celebrated. Watch will be kept at the Altar of Repose until 10pm when Night prayer will be sung. It is especially important that Eucharistic Ministers spend some time in prayer before the Altar of Repose on this sacred night. Please endeavour to make every effort to leave the Church in silence this evening.

### **GOOD FRIDAY (day of fast and abstinence)**

**St Thomas More** Caistor at 10am Stations of the Cross will be celebrated this morning.

**Holy Rood** at 3pm we celebrate the Passion of the Lord, please make a point of entering and leaving the Church in silence on this most solemn of days. At 7.30pm there will be a performance of Stainer's Crucifixion at the parish Church of St. Thomas all are welcome to attend. The collection taken today is for the Holy Places, the basket will be placed near the Cross at the veneration.
