JORDANHILL CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT
AND CALA HOMES

A 2nd **PUBLIC MEETING** will be held at 2pm on Sunday 19th March 2017 in Jordanhill Parish Church, Woodend Drive, in response to Cala Homes (West) application to the Council on Friday 3rd March to build 412 new homes on the Campus site.

By the time you receive this leaflet Glasgow City Council Planning Department will have processed the application and will imminently send Neighbour Notification letters to all properties bordering the Campus. These Neighbour Notifications trigger the 28-day period which residents have to lodge any representations or objections with the Planning Department.

The Public Meeting will explain to residents how to comment on the Planning Application, whom to contact and some issues you may wish to comment on. It will help make this process as simple as possible. The meeting will also present the Community Value Proposition recently submitted to The University of Strathclyde and City Council by the Community Council. The purpose of this document was to negotiate actual Community Benefit based on the University's original Campus Plan 2 and "legacy" proposals.

There will also be a discussion to explore funding options for the continued campaign against the current development proposals. To maximise the community's chances of success it is likely that substantial costs will need to be incurred covering areas such as an Independent Traffic Impact Assessment or other specialist consultant appointments and services.

Please attend the meeting. **YOUR COMMUNITY** is about to change forever. We believe the residents can still influence the way in which that change takes place if enough members of the community make their voices heard but it has to happen **NOW**.
