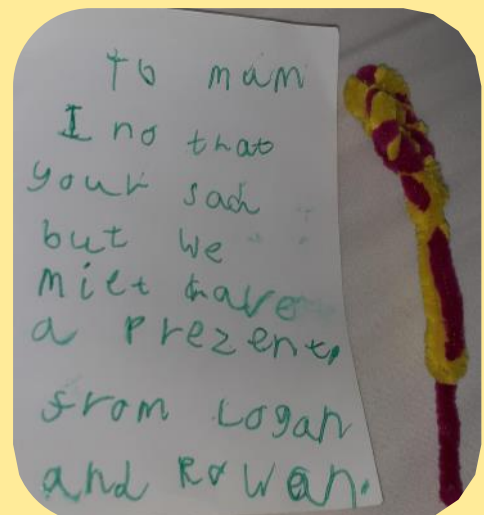
Virtue of the week
