The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is an allocation of funding provided to schools to support specific groups of children. These children included those who are entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), children who are Looked After (LAC) and children of Armed Forces Personnel. The funding is also allocated to those children who under the banner of 'Ever-6' – children who within their primary school education have been entitled to the PPG.
