Do's

- Encourage in your support
- Encourage them to play by the rules
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- Set a good example, applaud good play by all
- Publicly accept officials decisions and teach children to do likewise
- Show appreciation of volunteers, officials and coaches

Don'ts

- Ridicule or shout at a child for making a mistake
- Abuse or yell at teachers, officials etc, young players can't play the game without them.
- Use inappropriate language
- Confuse the players by telling them what to do, leave it to the teacher / coach.
- Don anything which is likely to offend by way of insult, humiliation or discrimination.
