The Logie Legacy was launched a charity in 2018 building on the work started by Dr Sandy Logie in 1991. It facilitates the St Francis Hospital Twinning Partnership with NHS Borders that was formally established in 2008.

Our partnership agreement supports global citizenship recognising that as individuals and organisations, we are interconnected, and our actions can impact both locally and globally. It upholds the key principles for effective involvement - ownership; alignment; harmonisation; evidence-based; sustainability; and mutual accountability

NHS Scotland has Global Citizenship as our national core value.
