Safeguarding Policy

Under The Mango Tree is committed to meeting safeguarding best practices and will constantly strive to:

- Promote a safer environment and culture
- Respond promptly to every safeguarding concern or allegation
- Care for victims/survivors of abuse and other affected persons
- Care for those who are the subject of concerns or allegations of abuse and other affected persons
- Respond to those that may pose a present risk to others

For the purpose of this policy the term abuse is defined as:

A violation of an individual's human and civil rights by any other person; or persons which may result in significant harm

Abuse may be:

A single act or repeated acts; an act of neglect or even a failure to act.

Context.

Under The Mango Tree employs no staff and does not own any buildings or premises. The charity does not work directly with any children or adults, vulnerable or not.

When giving talks to groups or holding fund raising events in other buildings charity volunteers will fully respect the safeguarding policies of those groups or establishments.

This policy will be reviewed annual at the charity annual general meeting.
