Some children **Walk barefoot**, up to 4 miles, to start at 7.30am collecting wood along the way for the school kitchen fire. Most, if not all the children

will arrive at school **WithOut** having eaten, so breakfast of sorghum is served, a runny porridge given in plastic cups, at 9am.



After more lessons, a lunch of rice, or ugali (white maize) and on two or three days per week kidney beans too. Helping to feed the minds and bodies of the children at Kambe Timboni School, Kenya
