


# HAMPSHIRE REGENCY DANCERS

Bath Carnival 1780

Triple minor with double progression

Dance step: Chasse

- 
- A1 1-8 1<sup>st</sup> couple dance through between ladies 2 and 3  
cast back individually back into middle of set, then dance out  
between men 2 and 3 to finish  
1<sup>st</sup> lady between the 2<sup>nd</sup> couple and  
1<sup>st</sup> man between the 3<sup>rd</sup> couple in two lines of three facing each  
other
- A2 1-2 In lines of three set R & L  
(no hands, working couple moving towards each other doing a  
quarter turn, couples 2 and 3 continue setting R & L)
- 3-4 1<sup>st</sup> couple half 2H turn to finish improper in side line
- 5-6 In lines of three all set R & L
- 7-8 1<sup>st</sup> couple half 2H turn to own side, whilst couples 2 and 3  
continue setting R & L
- B1 1-8 Hands 6 in circle L then R
- B2 1-4 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couple half a pousette anti-clockwise  
(1<sup>st</sup> man pull to start)
- 5-8 1<sup>st</sup> couple and next couple below, half a pousette clockwise  
(1<sup>st</sup> man 'push' to start)
