

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Closing Date: All entries must be received by Wednesday 26 September. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Entries Secretary, subject to a £5.00 supplement.
2. Withdrawals: by email to info@horse-events.co.uk by Wednesday 26 September. There will be no refund of entry fees after this date.
3. Starting times will be allocated for all classes. Go to www.horse-events.co.uk or www.foxhill-farm.com or www.graftonhunt.co.uk
4. The course will be open for inspection on Saturday 29 September from 2pm. Competitor briefings on Optimum Time at 3pm and 5pm in the Sponsors' Tent.
5. Course enquiries call 01295 760230.
6. No watches or timing equipment to be worn/carried by any rider while competing on the course.
7. Competitors must wear back protectors, crash hats to BSI standard and medical armbands.
8. Competitors should bring their own number bib. Bibs will be available to purchase.
9. All riders must wear a hat at all times when riding.
10. No horse/pony to compete more than once in any one class.
11. Junior riders to be aged 8 years or over.
12. When not competing riders must ride in the designated practice areas and only jump flagged fences.
13. Eliminated riders may continue at the discretion of the course officials.
14. Veterinary cover will be provided on the day, all fees to be met by the individual.
15. All dogs to be kept on leads.
16. Only official vehicles will be allowed on the course.
17. Please take all your litter home with you.
18. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and to refuse any entry for any reason what so ever.
19. The organising committee of The Grafton Hunt will not accept any liability whatsoever for any injury, accident, illness or damage to any horse, rider, spectator, or any other person or property.
