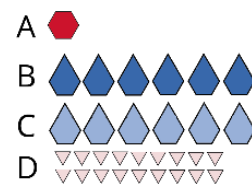

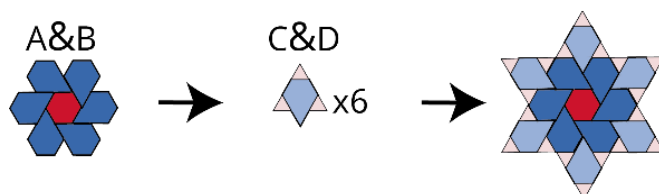


You will need:

- From fabric **C** (6) 1" Jewels
- From fabric **D** (18) 1" Equilateral Triangles



Let's Get Stitching...



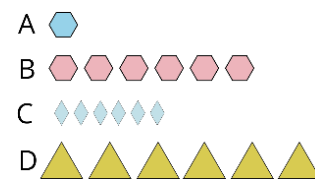
