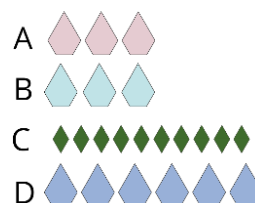
**Draco**..... a fierce dragon, features in many myths. A favourite is in the tale of Hercules (son of Zeus).

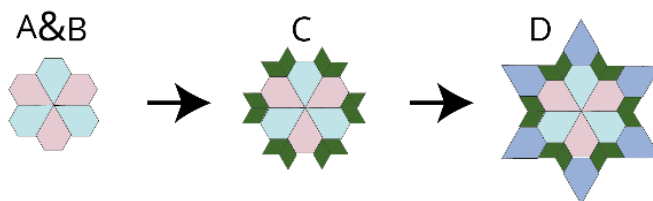


**You will need:**

- From fabric **A** (3) 1" Jewels
- From fabric **B** (3) 1" Jewels
- From fabric **C** (12) 1" 6 Point Diamonds
- From fabric **D** (6) 1" Jewels

He is often shown with his body wrapped around the North Pole with one foot placed upon Hercules head.

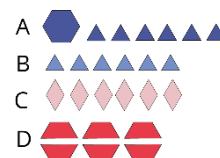
**Aries**..... is another one of the constellations of the zodiac and is most commonly represented in the form of a ram.

**You will need:**

- From fabric **A** (1) 1 ½" Hexie & (6) 1 ½" Equilateral Triangles
- From fabric **B** (6) 1 ½" Equilateral Triangles
- From fabric **C** (6) 1 ½" 6 Point Diamonds
- From fabric **D** (6) 1 ½" Half Hexies
