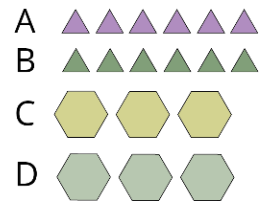

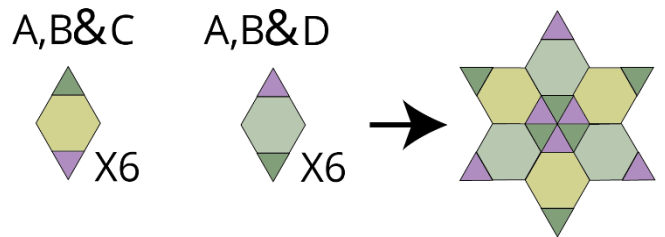


You will need:

- From fabric **B** (6) 1 ½" Equilateral Triangles
- From fabric **C** (3) 1 ½" Hexies
- From fabric **D** (3) 1 ½" Hexies



Let's Get Stitching...

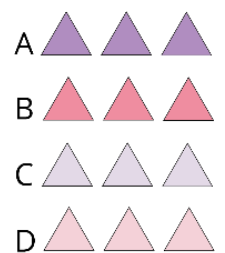
