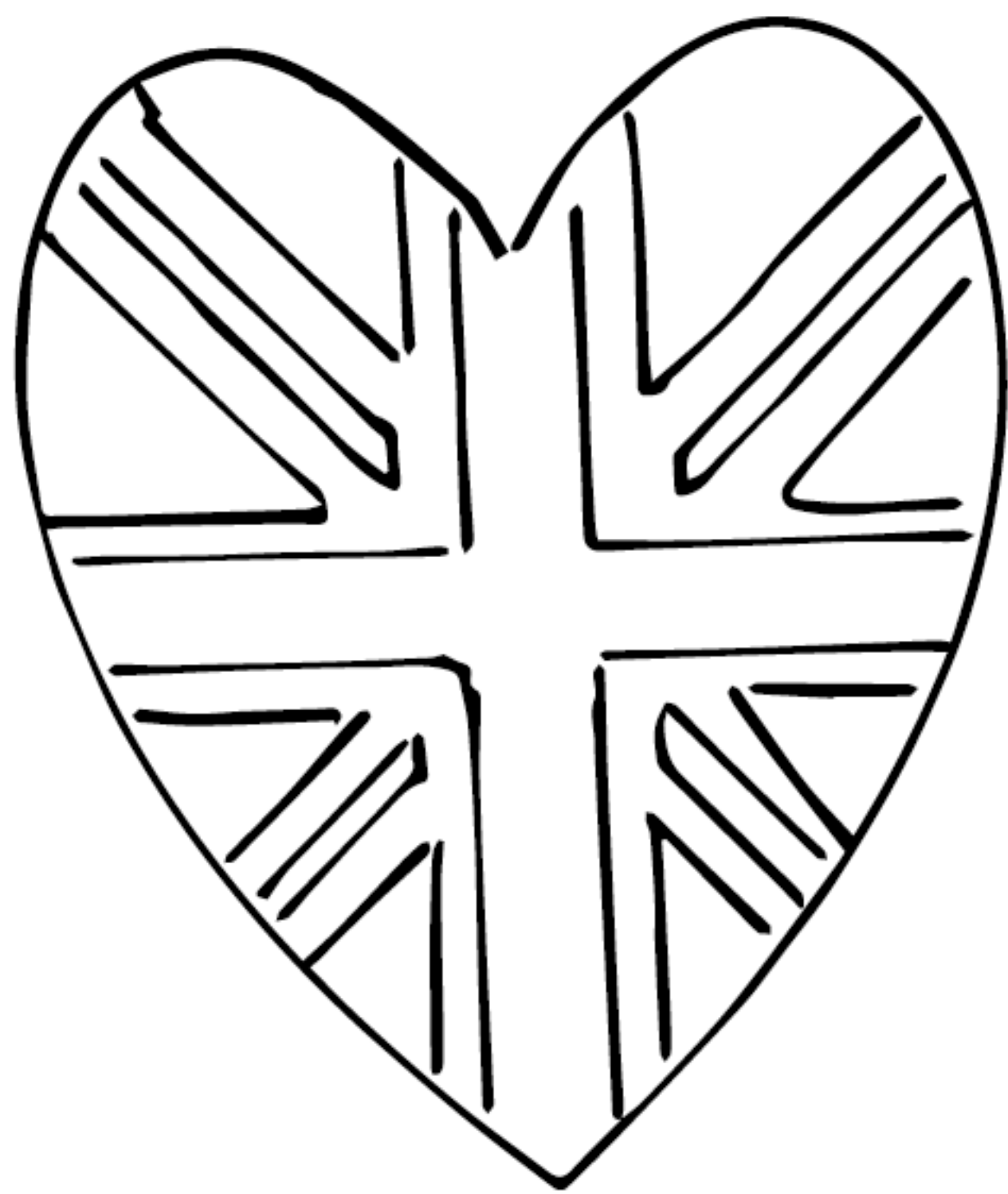


Union Jack Heart

Happy Jubilee Weekend! I originally stitched my Union Jack heart on my #sewalittlehappinesseveryday sampler back in Lockdown.

As we celebrate our wonderful Queens Platinum Jubilee, it occurred that you may also wish to stitch one. So, today I am sharing the pattern and simple instructions!

First, transfer the pattern to your fabric of choice.

Remember, there is 'a little happy' tutorial on the blog to help you.

Now for your happy stitches, I used Satin Stitch for the RED elements and French Knots for the BLUE & WHITE elements.

I went for a slightly 'vintagy' feel with mine and throughout, I used 2 strands separated from the main strand of floss, in the following colours:

red ~ DMC 221
blue ~ DMC 926
white ~ DMC Ecu
