

Minutes of Neighbourhood Plan meeting Held Thursday 26th July, 2018.

Roecliffe & Westwick Parish Council

In attendance: Dave Siswick, Richard Booth, Jo Mitchell. Scott Green, David Gluck.

The purpose of the meeting was to run through the latest draft plan and offer corrections/additions. These are as the following notes.

Page 7 clarify the flow diagram

Obtain a better village map possibly from HBC so that individual houses can be shown.

Check the actual number of questionnaire respondents there were (Paul Say?)

Investigate the development history of Westwick (if any).

Elaborate on how applications for planning matters can demonstrate community involvement.

Key views have been distilled down to six key views.

Access to facilities were likely to change dramatically over the lifespan of the plan

Policy B3 to be removed.

Page 41 should include a mention of the library.

Details for appendices to be obtained showing “Non designated local heritage assets”, “local green spaces” and “community facilities”.

It was hoped that the above can be achieved in a couple of weeks such that the report might then be submitted to HBC for informal comments.

The budget for David Gluck’s services was examined and assurance given that the project can be completed within this budget.

It was agreed that an active village website was the medium for displaying details of this plan to the public, and it was noted that there was some monies (£400) set aside to update and reformat the Roecliffe.org website.
