car parking is limited on the forecourt of the Edenbridge Hall but there are several other options to park your car nearby. The Leisure Centre car park is the obvious choice for many of you – it is about 250 paces from the front of the Leisure Centre to the hall entrance.

Not only are we changing the venue for our monthly meetings we are changing our meeting times. From September our monthly meetings will be on the same day but will be in the morning and, a date for your diary: TUESDAY 28th SEPTEMBER, will be our first

full meeting with a guest speaker. Our committee are busy finetuning this important change and I will keep you updated in my monthly newsletter. Perhaps this is a good time to remind you of our fabulous U3A team.
