Notice to residents of Austwick

Ingleborough Estate forestry works

Planning consent C/18/146E for creation of timber wagon turning and timber stacking area; maintenance and improvement of timber extraction route and installation of reinforced concrete crossing over the sheep underpass at Long Lane, Thwaite Lane and Thwaite Wood, Ingleborough Estate, Clapham

Ingleborough Estate has informed Austwick Parish Council as follows:

“Preparatory work on the track improvement of Thwaite Lane will start very shortly. Stone won’t start to be delivered until middle to end of April, with lorries delivering through to possibly July. There will be no more than 6 stone lorry deliveries per day, the contractor cannot be specific, some days less and some days none at all. At the moment there is no planned timetable for the extraction of any timber because there is so much preparatory work to be done first.”

Please note:

- **Details of the route HGVs will take through Austwick are included in planning consent C/18/146E. A Risk Assessment has been approved as consent C/18/146E/DIS1.**
- **The frequency of stone lorry deliveries referred to above complies with the conditions of the planning consent.**
- **Austwick Parish Council has made repeated requests that Ingleborough Estate provides full details of its forestry works programme direct to Austwick residents, either by a meeting or other appropriate means, and has offered to facilitate this. No response to these requests has been received.**
