MEDIBUS

Over the past year, the GoFar has continued to provide transport for the East Riding of Yorkshires MediBus service. This service takes passengers to appointments and visiting in Goole and Scunthorpe hospitals. We have also carried passengers to appointments for the doctors, dentists, opticians, podiatry clinics, ophthalmology clinics and diabetic clinics in Goole, Howden, Snaith and Gilberdyke.

We saw a big rise in passengers being taken to Scunthorpe hospital for appointments and also visiting, as well as the Ironstone Centre in Scunthorpe for ophthalmology appointments. There are bus and rail services to Scunthorpe, but it is very hard to connect with these in time for appointments. The railway station is also quite away from the hospital and for some this would need an additional taxi ride

Over the past year we have carried **695** passengers and travelled approximately **17,393** miles in our vehicles.

We expect to be just as busy – if not busier over the coming year with the MediBus, offering our friendly, door to door accessible transport solutions to people in the community who need to attend medical appointments at hospitals, doctor's surgeries and clinics.
