BONFIRES ARE PERMITTED

from

1 October to the 31 May

Please remember:

- All green waste must be composted wherever possible
- Any green waste for burning must be covered and be fully dry before burning
- Fires must not be lit on clear or sunny days or when neighbours have windows open or washing out
- Fires must not be lit when the wind direction would cause smoke to blow towards the houses or across any roads bordering the site
- If a fire starts to smoke or the wind changes direction, the fire must be put out quickly
- Fires should not produce thick smoke at any time and must not be used for burning anything other than plant material
- Keep a bucket of water close by in case the fire starts to get out of control
- Fires MUST be put out BEFORE you leave the site

NOTE: If a larger than normal bonfire is planned, or it produces a lot of smoke, please inform the Wilts & Dorset Fire Call Centre on **0306 799 0019**. This will reduce the risk of the Fire Service being called out unnecessarily. If the Fire Service is required then use the same number **NOT** 999

Thank you for your cooperation – to continue being able to have bonfires, it is important that we are considerate of our neighbours and avoid complaints
