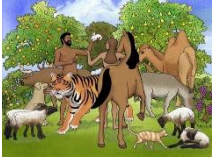


P is for Perfect

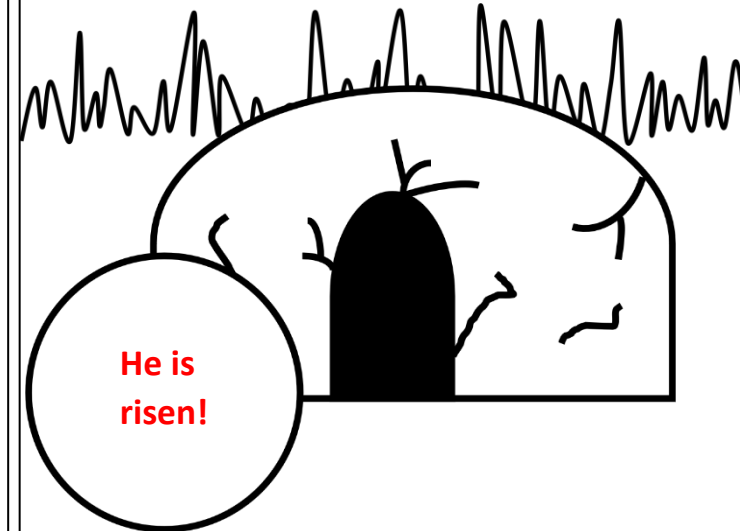
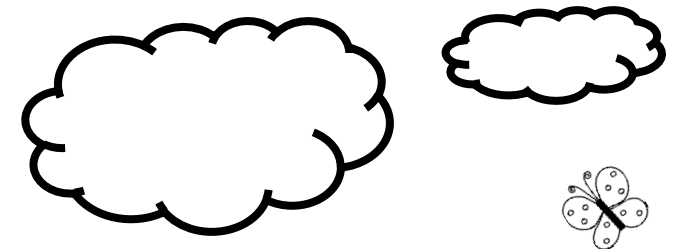
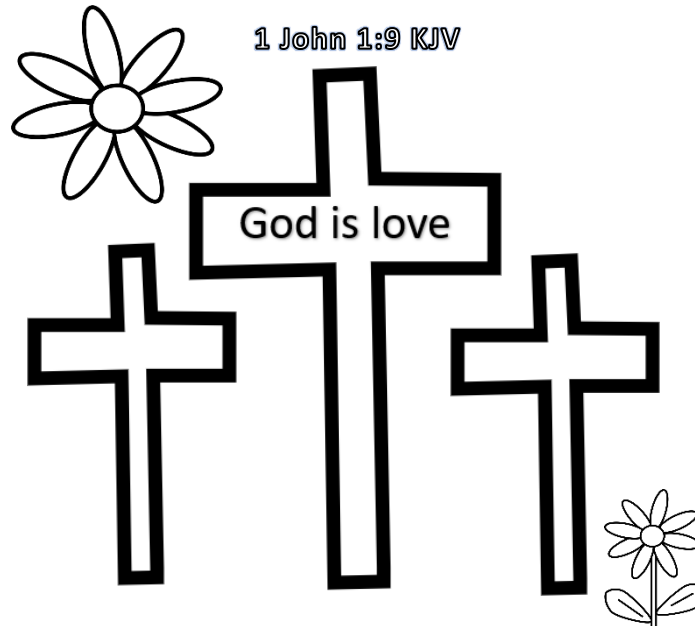
