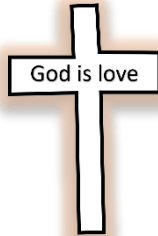


Patrick's Peace

Romans 5 v 1 kjv



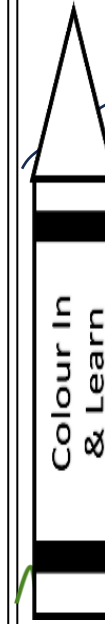
Pray Like Patrick

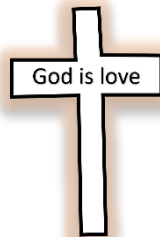

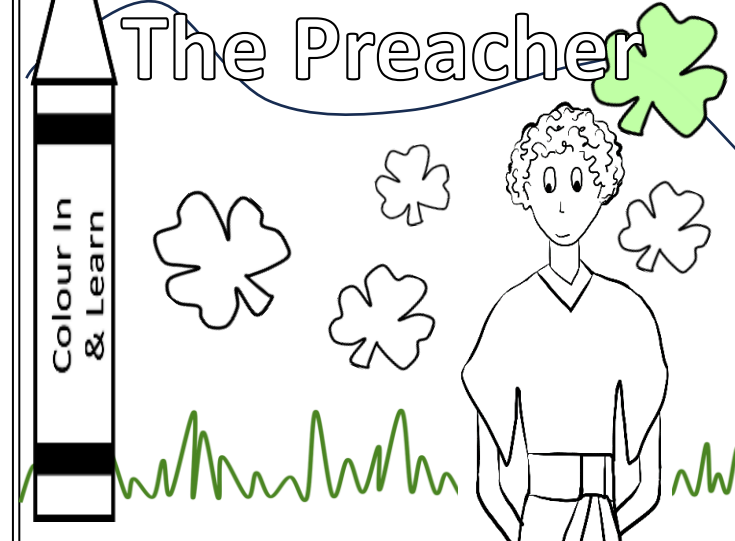
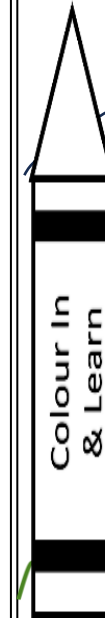
Pray Like Patrick

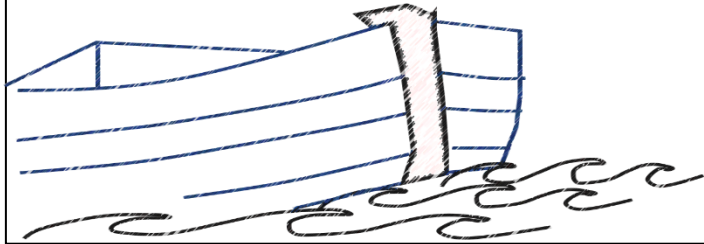
Patrick & The Pirates

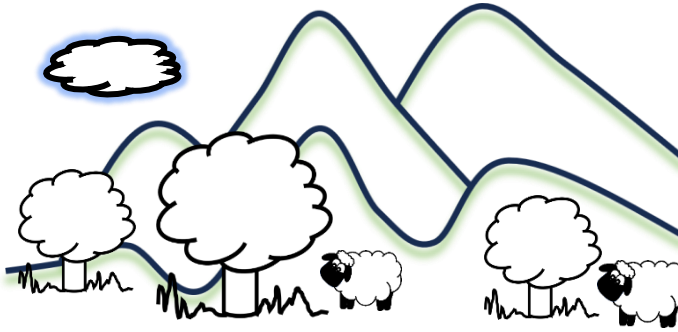

Patrick wrote about how he had been like a stone in deep mud. Then he called on God to lift him out of the mud, and onto a rock.

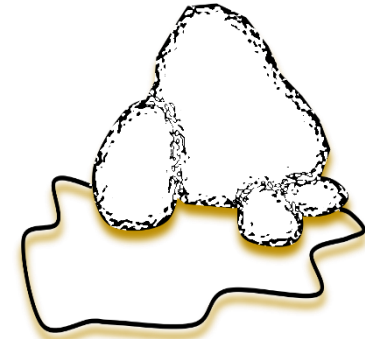
The **“mud”** reminds us of **sin**, the **“rock”** is Jesus.

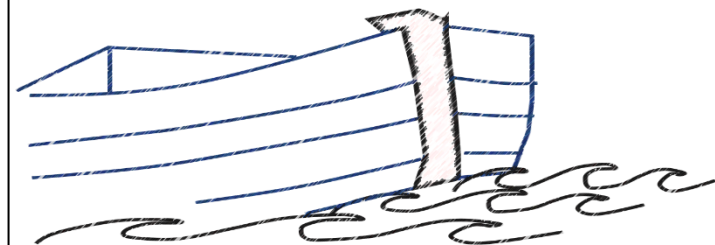

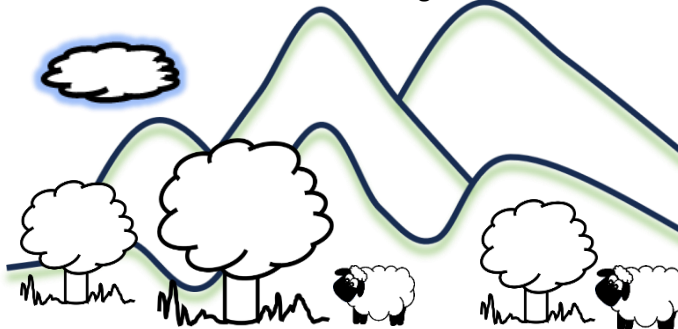
