

# God Made The Rainbow

- The first time we read about a rainbow in the Bible is in the very first book, the book of **Genesis** (chapter 9 verses 8-16).
- God placed a “bow” in the clouds as a sign that He would never again destroy all the earth with a flood.
- The Hebrew word used for bow can mean a rainbow or an archery bow.
- God was showing mercy and promising not to destroy the earth in this way again.
- The archers bow is harmless without an arrow!
- Next time you see a bow and arrow think of the rainbow and God's promise of mercy.
- **God keeps His promises!**

- Rainbows are also mentioned in the book of **Ezekiel** and in **Revelation**.
- That means we read about rainbows in the first and last books of the Bible!
