- 2 YDNPA: C/31/664 – full planning permission for erection of a replacement dwelling (to replace steel framed bungalow), erection of replacement garage and creation of new vehicular access from Stackhouse Lane, Galadale, Stackhouse Lane. ***Approved conditionally***
- 3 CDC: 2022/23664/CND – Application to discharge condition no.3 (Remediation Strategy) on planning permission referenced 2018/19695/FUL, Land South Of Station Road. ***Split decision.*** To **note** that this condition is partially discharged. The condition is considered discharged in relation to Plots 1-3, with the requirement that a further validation report is submitted for Plot 4 upon completion of the approved Remediation Strategy and before Plot 4 is brought into use.
