Submissions

- **Up to 5** framed paintings, drawings, limited edition prints, photographs, sculpture - your own original work - signed, well framed and ready to hang by wire or cord. No more than 1 piece may be listed as NFS (Not for sale) Each piece must have a title (not item 1,2 or 3)
- **Up to 3** mounted, signed but unframed works. All works must have a label affixed to the back, with the title, price, medium and name of the artist.
- **Greeting Cards**, 50 maximum. Cards must have a label affixed to the back with the price and name of the artist. Cards for sale at exhibition must have details submitted by August 1st.

Entry Forms

Catalogue

- We would appreciate a brief resume (no more than 50 words) of the artist together with the titles, medium used and prices of work submitted for the catalogue. To save duplications of effort and possible errors, your resume may be e-mailed to joware40@gmail.com

Handing in

- Submissions are to be handed in at The Hopelands, Weobley Village Hall on **Friday August 26th, between 9.30am and 1pm**

Entry Fee

- A hanging fee of £1.00 will be charged for each framed picture exhibited. Canvases are classified as framed picture
- A fee of £2.00 will be charged for a folio of unframed pictures.
- There is no charge for submitting greetings cards.
- Fees (waived for current members of FOWPC) are to be paid at the handing-in. **Please do not send money with entry form.**

Commission

- Paintings should be priced to include 20% commission, if sold, to be retained by FOWPC, as a donation to their funds. Minimum price for any work is £35 framed. £25 unframed.

Collection

- Unsold work should be collected after the close of the exhibition on **Monday August 29th, between 5.15 - 6.00pm**. Please do not expect to collect your work before then.

Conditions

- FOWPC reserves the right to decide which pictures will be hung. In the unlikely event of the rejection of any works (e.g. If more works are submitted than can be accommodated) we will first contact the artist.

Whilst all normal care will be taken of exhibitors work, FOWPC will not be held responsible for any loss or damage during the course of the exhibition. Exhibitors should make their own arrangements for any insurance cover they require.
