CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Submissions

- Up to 5 framed paintings, drawings, limited edition prints, photographs, sculpture – all works should be 'own original' work - signed, correctly framed and ready to hang by wire or cord. No more than one piece may be listed as NFS (Not for Sale). Each piece should be clearly titled (not item 1,2 or 3)
- Up to 3 mounted, signed but unframed works. All works should have a label affixed to the back, with the title, price, medium and name of the artist.
- A maximum of 50 cards may be submitted. All cards should have a label affixed to the back with the price and name of the artist. Cards for sale at exhibition should provide details to the organiser by August 1st.

Entry Forms

- We would appreciate a brief resume (no more than 50 words) of the artist together with the titles, medium used and prices of work submitted for the catalogue on your fillable PDF entry form.

Handing in

- Submissions are to be handed in at the Weobley Village Hall on the Friday immediately before the exhibition between 9.30am and 12.30pm

Entry Fee

- A hanging fee of £2.00 will be charged for each framed picture exhibited. Canvases are classified as framed picture.
- A fee of £2.00 will be charged for a folio of unframed pictures.
- There is no charge for submitting greetings cards.

- Fees (waived for current members of FOWPC) are to be paid at the handing-in. Please do not send money with entry form.

Commission

- Paintings should be priced to include 20% commission. If sold this money shall be retained by FOWPC, as a donation to their funds. Minimum price to be charged for any work is £35 framed or £25 unframed.

Collection

- Unsold work should be collected after the close of the exhibition on August Bank Holiday between 5.15pm and 6.00pm. Please do not collect your work before the exhibition closes.

Conditions

- FOWPC reserves the right to decide which pictures will be hung. In the unlikely event if the rejection of any works (e.g., If more work is submitted than can be accommodated) we will contact the artist.
- Whilst all normal care will be taken of exhibitors' work, FOWPC will not be held responsible for any loss or damage during the exhibition. Exhibitors should make their own arrangements for any insurance cover they require.
