The meeting commenced at 7pm



- 1) Draft Minutes of the General Meeting held on 2nd February 2022 were accepted and signed by C.Edwards as a true record.
- 2) Matters Arising
 - a) The campsite at Moorhampton had offered to make their defibrillator publicly available. The council decided not to pursue this due to the cost of a cabinet, ongoing maintenance and installation. A significant number of the potential users were at the campsite and so would have access anyway. R.Hallett to feed back to A.Powell.
 - b) Following discussions with Balfour Beatty and the Herefordshire Safer Roads Partnership the best course of action at the junction of the A480/B4230 was felt to be and aggressive hedge cut later in the year. R.Hallett to feed back to A.Powell.
 - c) S.Hallett stated that as the Local Plan progressed through the consultation phases, we should continue to monitor its development. She would flag up anything that needed bringing to the council's attention
- 3) Finance
 - a) The regular report was presented (see Agenda).
- 4) Highways
 - a) A Lengthsman contract has been signed between Foxley Group and Herefordshire Council. R.Hallett will now compile the contract to be signed between Foxley Group and Richard Mills.
 - b) Foxley Group has been awarded £4339 of the £8370 applied for as a drainage grant. Following discussion with Balfour Beatty and R.Mills it is still possible to deliver most of the planned work
- 5) Planning: No comments to make against the current application, P220323/F, P220894/L
- 6) Any Other Business
 - a) The report from M.Jones was presented his absence (Appendix 1)
 - b) In the region of 90 residents have replied to the invitation for the Jubilee Street Party.
 - c) The Talk Parish Reference Group has defined a new process for representation. Foxley Group is in a group with 42 other parish councils. We are supposed to co-ordinate between ourselves to identify 4 representatives. It is felt that this is not workable
