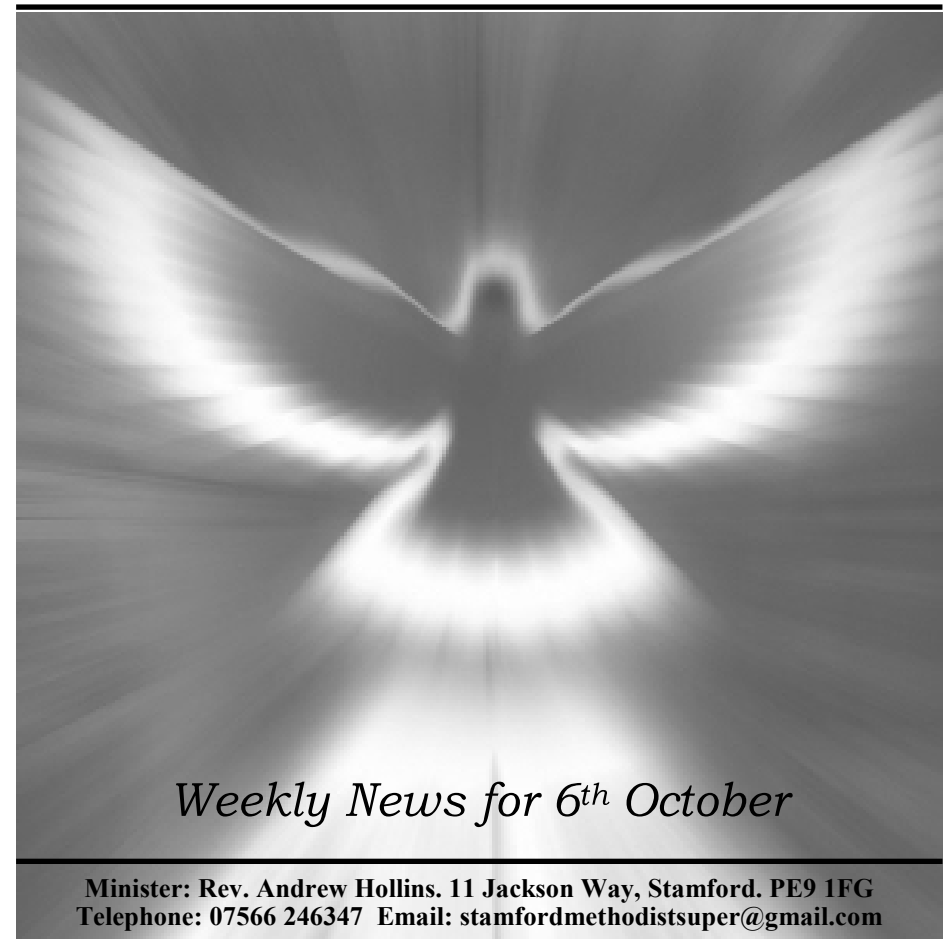
A hearing loop operates in the main Church and in the Wesley Room. Please switch your hearing aid to its 'T' setting to make use of this facility.

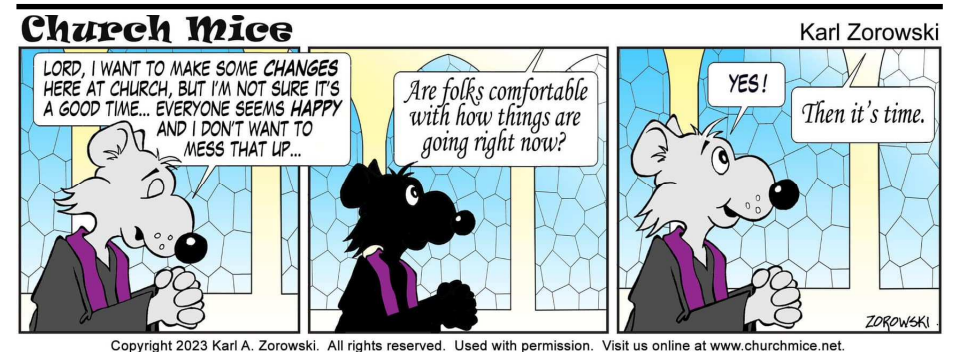
