Code of Conduct for Adult Members

As a member of WC&TCC, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the Laws of Cricket, understand and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials who are usually volunteers. They give their time and resources to provide cricket for you.
- All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.
- All members should be a positive role model by treating other players and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.
- Members should use correct and proper language at all times.
- Members should only drink alcohol in moderation on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members must not consume drugs on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and matches or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager/captain.
- Members must pay membership or training fees promptly.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated. Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.

Facilities/Equipment.

The Club is committed to providing high standards and as such has available the following: artificial wicket, mobile batting cage, bowling machine and three full sized nets. Playing equipment will also always be made available.

Match fees.

1st XI and 2nd XI match fees are £7 for members and £14 for non members (which includes players who are late with membership fees). The match fee will be used to cover the cost of teas and refreshments, and partially cover the cost of preparing home facilities, in particular the playing areas. 3rd XI match fees are £6 for members and £12 for non members (which again includes players who are late with their membership fees).

Club Changing Policy.

This policy applies to players under the age of 18 playing in adult teams. Parental consent must be given if young players are to share changing facilities with adults.
