Emergency Vehicle Access to the Ground

Access to the recreation ground is via the tarmac village hall car park readily accessible from the public highway. Entrance to the ground itself is via a 3 meter plus gate that is unlocked (the chain lifts over the post). This access is constantly in use and therefore monitored regularly.

There is no public phone box on site but high likelihood that staff and parents in attendance will have mobile phones; a public phone box is 500 yards away to the south. Emergency telephone numbers are listed above and posted on the Cricket Club Notice Board.

Safety Information

The evacuation procedure for the club house is to exit via the nearest doorway out onto the playing field; each doorway has emergency exit signs & lighting. There are doorways exiting from the building in the main pavilion room, kitchen, and both dressing rooms. This procedure will be listed on the Cricket Club Notice Board.
