Debbie Lyddon

Debbie is a textile artist and maker based in Wells-next-the-Sea, Norfolk, whose work explores landscape and place and includes mixed media cloths, sculpture, installation and drawing. Her inspiration comes from experiencing and paying attention to her surroundings.

Cloth is at the centre of Debbie's practice which combines traditional stitch techniques with non-traditional materials such as bitumen, salt and wax to make ambiguous 2-D and 3-D works that evoke the sights, sounds and touch of natural environments.

"My practice aims to present a multi-sensory interpretation of my surroundings – one that can be seen, touched and heard."

Debbie has an MA in Contemporary Textiles from the University of Hertfordshire and is a member of the 62 Group of Textile Artists and the Society of Designer Craftsmen.
