

This then provides a rich resource to explore in a 'working' sketchbook - a place to be free and develop ideas in her unique method combining painting drawing and stitch. Amanda layers up papers, threads and fabric scraps to create a surface which can be worked freely with machine drawn stitch.

The scale of Amanda's work ranges from large hangings to small wall mounted panels and framed textile artworks.
