## Alice Fox


Alice's process-led practice is based on personal engagement with landscape. Her background in physical geography and nature conservation underpins her artistic practice.

Alice works with natural fibres, found objects and gathered materials, employing natural dye techniques, print, stitch and weave in different combinations to create surfaces and structures.


Alice works from her studio in Saltaire, West Yorkshire and recently completed an MA in Creative Practice at Leeds Arts University.
