

# ARTISTS in ACTION

## Jill Flower

Jill is a mix-media textile artist working from her home studio in Westcott Surrey.

Last year she completed a 2 year project using discarded scraps of fabric found on the jungle floor in Africa- "Memories of AJ", the work was inspired by the tiny fragments, the patterns, colour and stitch designs found on African costumes. She said she "*loved working on a purely hand stitch project, it made a refreshing alternative from machining!*"

Recently, Jill has started to research for a new body of work with her dynamic textile art group Studio21 called 'Addressing Space'. This investigates the possible use of three incidental words as a postcode locator.

This time she has returned to experimenting with papers, magazines, layering paints and inks, and patterning with machine stitch to form what she describes as a "fabric". The Fabric is deconstructed and reconstructed to form a final piece describing the random three words indicating the location of her studio.
