

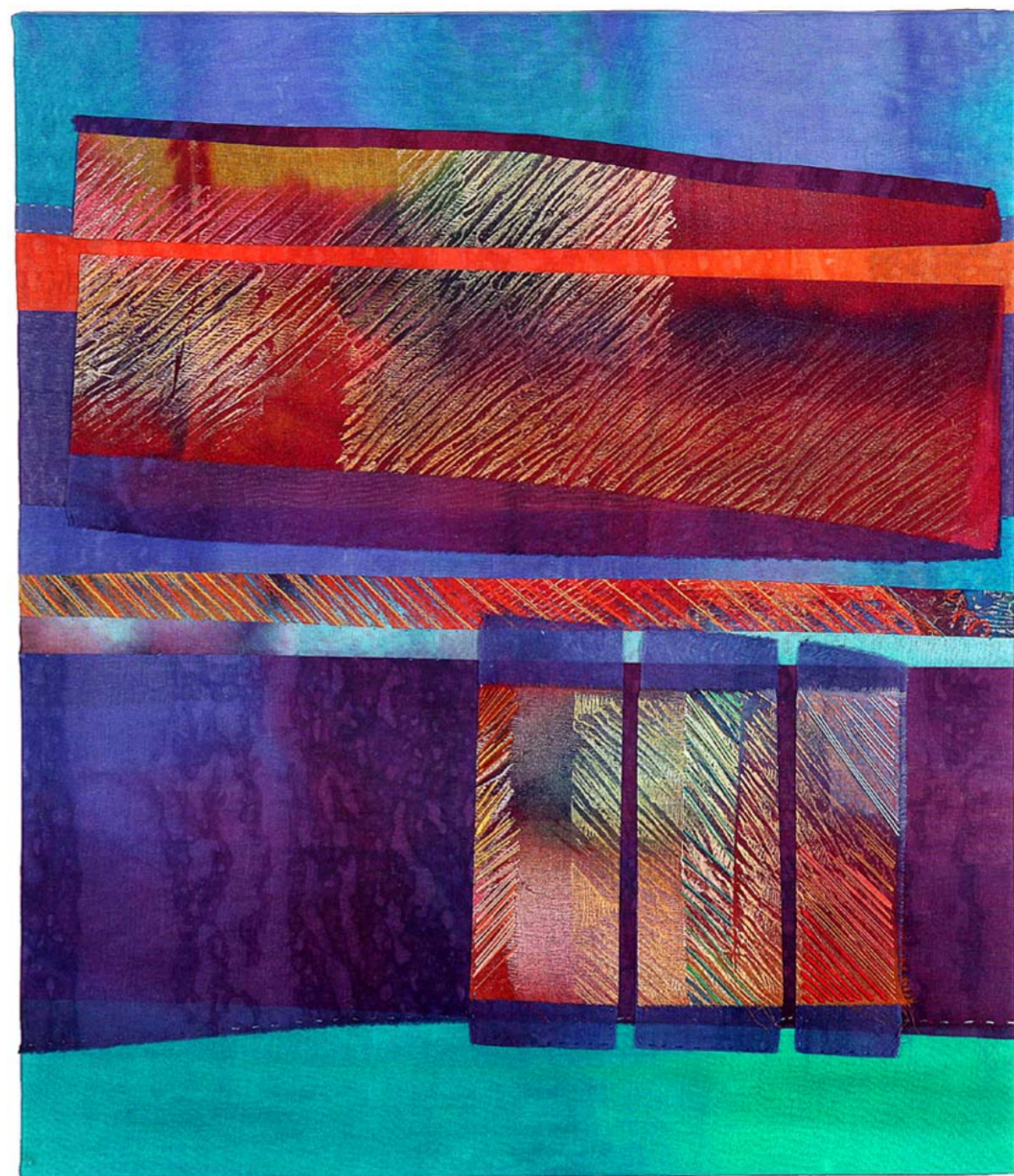
ARTISTS in ACTION Harrogate

Colour is central to Ruth's work and textile practice, using a variety of printed, dyed and stitched techniques on paper and fabric. Her work is a continual exploration of stitched and dyed surfaces, interpreted in a range of different formats and scale but always using vibrant colour.

A graduate of Birmingham College of Art, she has taught and exhibited nationally and internationally for many years as well as having written six books on the use of colour and different textile processes. For many years she would be seen enjoying and sharing her colour enthusiasms on The Art Van Go stand!

Now living and working in rural Shropshire, Ruth enjoys having time to focus on her work in her studio as well as occasional tutoring commitments.
