



### You Will Need:

- Pattern piece
- Fabric
- Sewing machine or hand sewing needle
- Sewing scissors
- Threads
- Iron & ironing board
- Chopstick or pencil



1) Iron your fabric. Print out the bunting triangle template and cut it out.

2) Fold your fabric in half with the right sides facing the inside so that you can cut two flags at the same time. Place your pattern piece onto the edge of your fabric and pin in place using the pins in your kit.



3) Take the pins out. Transfer the pins back to your double layer of fabric.



4) Set your machine up and thread with a nicely matching thread. You will sew one flag at a time. Using a 1 cm seam allowance stitch the two longest seams together, remembering to backstitch at the beginning and end.



5) Bunting triangle with stitches in dark colour so you can see them.



6) Trim the bottom of each point off carefully, making sure you don't cut into your stitch line.



7) Turn each flag the right way round and poke the bottom through very carefully with a chopstick or blunt pencil. Snip off excess fabric at the top edge.



8) Press your flags with a hot iron.
